




The Renewable Energy Act - EEG

Feed-in tariff

Examples feed-in tariff

<i>Modality</i>	<i>Feed-in tariff / €ct/kWh</i> depending on system size
PV	8.53 – 12.31 €ct/kWh
Wind onshore	8.20 – 8.58 first 5 years 4.39 – 4.77 later
Wind offshore	15.00 – 15.40 first 12 years 3.50 – 3.90 later
Biomass	10.34 – 13.39
